School Annual Report 2019

Good Evening ladies and gentlemen,

Hon'ble Chief Guest Maj. Gen. S.S. Nair, AVSM (Retd.), Director, BET, Dy. Director (Finance) Mr. K.K. Pareek, Director Birla Science Centre, Dr. V.N. Dhaulakhandi, Principals of various BET Schools, invited parents, teachers and my dear students. I am indeed thankful to Syt. S.K.Birla ji & Mrs. Sumangala Birlaji for their continuous & unconditional support. It gives me immense pleasure to welcome you all to the 119th Annual Function and Prize giving ceremony. It is well known fact that the Birla School has always kept its flag high and the hallmarks established by the predecessors have been maintained for the last 119 years. It is a matter of immense pride for me to stand here and present before you the inventory of achievements and activities executed in the session 2018 and 2019.

At the outset I would like to share our class XII and X results with you. Like previous years this year also we have had good results.

- Master Rahul topped the Science stream with 95.60% while Master Subhash Rajpurohit stood second with 94.8% marks.
- 113 Students secured above 75% marks in aggregate
- 199 Students secured I Division.
- 24 students secured 100 % marks in individual subjects (01 Student in Mathematic, 03 in I.P., 02 in Physical Education, 14 in Music & 04 Students in Painting)
- 36 Students secured 90% and above marks in aggregate
- School averages for the session 2019:
 - Science 77.3% while for commerce it was 68.81%.
- Master Gagandeep topped in class X CBSE examination with 97.40% while Master Lalit Chandra and stood Second and third with 98.60% and 96.40% marks respectively.
- 69 Students secured more than 75% marks in aggregate.
- 02 Students secured 100% marks in FIT.
- 02 Students secured 100% marks in Maths.
- 01 Student secured 100% in Social Science.
- 34 Students secured more than 90% and above marks in aggregate.
- School average this year has been 74.30.

- On 02th February, 2019 Department of Chemical Engineering, BITS Pilani has organized “*Scientific Model Competition-EXTROPY 2019*” at BITS, Pilani, our students in Senior Category got Ist Position and IIIrd position in Junior Category.
- On 10th February, Founder’s Day of B.E.T. was celebrated at Shardapeeth. Our staff and students participated with full interest. Some of the staff members and students were felicitated for their significant academic and co-curricular records.

- In the category under 19 age group, Aditya Pawriya and Atharva Pareek jointly won championship and under category 17 Lakshya Rathi won individual championship. School won overall District School Championship boys under 17 and 19 and was declared district champion for the year 2019 -20.
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- From 6th September to 9th September 2019, swimming team of BSP participated in 64th Educational Inter School District Swimming meet held at Rakesh Academy Sr. Sec. School Pilani,
- From our school 19 students (16 boys and 03 Girls) participated, in the category of boys and girls U/14, We won 20 Gold, 09 Silver and 03 bronze Medals.
