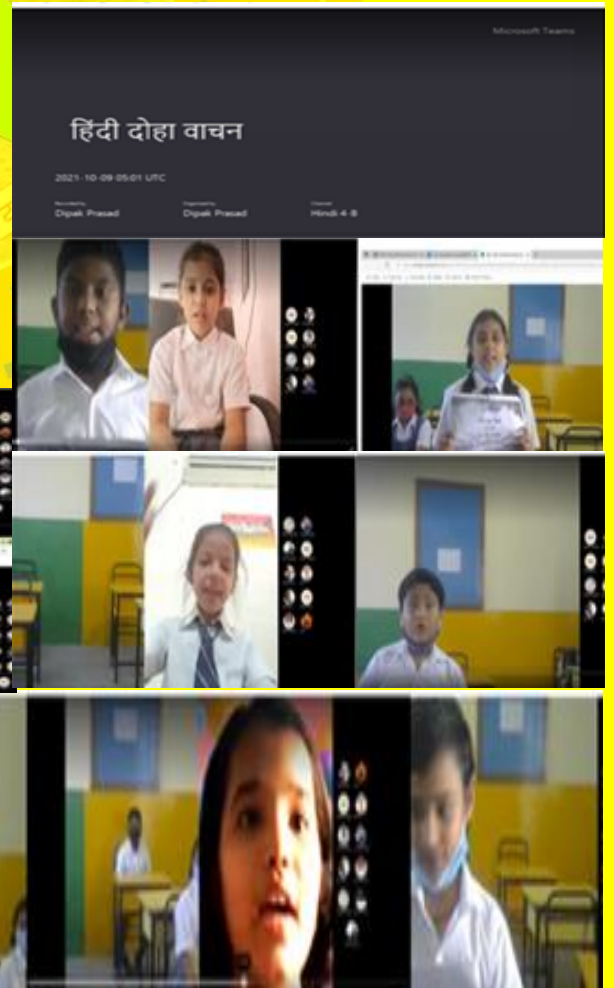

Diya Decoration and Card Making (30 October 2021)

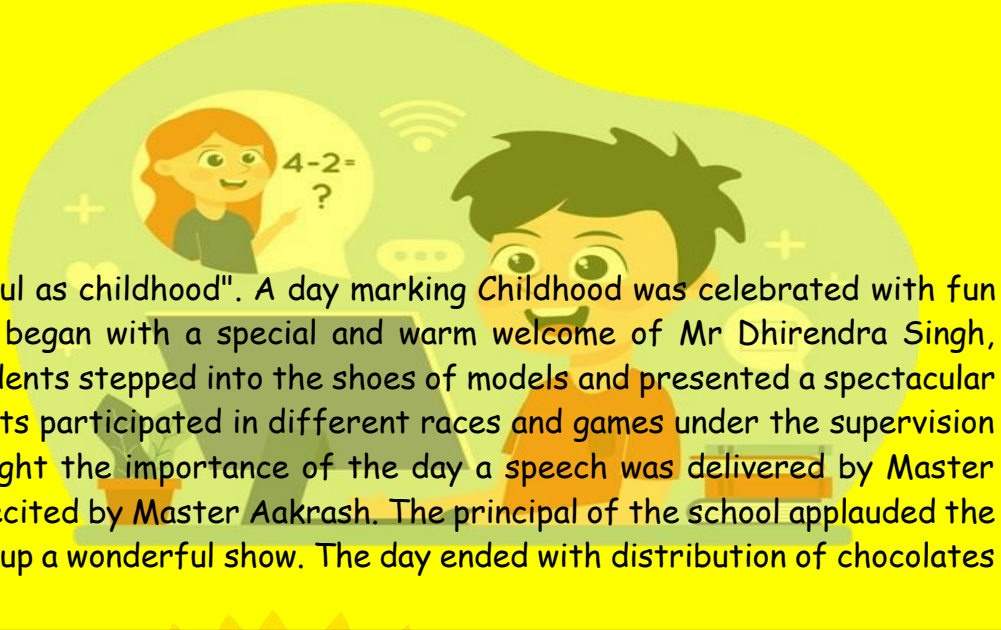
